**Transportation: Air-flight and car transfer (bus)**

**Season: during whole year**

**Description: A historical and architectural tour of the amazingly beautiful and unique cities of Uzbekistan which is composed of a combination of historical and modern architectural, cultural and ethnographic components.**

<p><b>Day 1 Tashkent</b> Arrival to Tashkent, meeting and accommodation in a hotel.</p>	
<p><b>Day 2 Tashkent – Urgench – Khiva</b> Breakfast. Visit to Xasti Imam complex, market Chorsu, madrassah of Kukeldash, museum of Applied Art, square of Amir Temur, monument of Braveness, square People’s friendship. Departure to airport for flight to Urgench. Upon arrival, transfer to Khiva, accommodation in a hotel.</p>	
<p><b>Day 3 Khiva</b> Excursion on town, visit to architectural complex of Ichan-Kala (X-XIX cent), residence of last Khan, including Mausoleum of Ismail Xadja, Madrassah of Muhammad Amin Khan, castle Kunya Ark (XVI – XVII cent), minaret Kalta Minor, Tash-Xauli palace (XIX cent), Paxlavan Mahmud mausoleum (XIV – XVIII cent), Djuma mosque (X cent).</p>	

<p><b>Day 4 Khiva – Bukhara</b> Leaving for Bukhara via Kyzylkum desert (480 km, 6-7 hours). Arrival to Bukhara. Accomodation in a hotel.</p>	
<p><b>Day 5 Bukhara</b> Excursion on town: Ark citadel (IV cent B.C.), Samanids mausoleum (9-10 век), Chashma Ayubi (XIV cent), Bolo House mosque (beginning of XX cent.), Nodir – Divan – Begi madrassah, Lyabi House complex (XIV – XVII cent.), Kalyan minaret (XII cent.), Kalyan mosque (XII cent.), Miri Arab madrassah (XVI cent.).</p>	
<p><b>Day 6 Bukhara</b> Leaving for countryside for visiting Bahouddin Nakshband mausoleum (XVI – XIX cent), where his mother and his relatives are buried (XIV cent); Chor – Bakr mausoleum (X cent), summer residence of Sitarai Moxi Xossa (XIX cent).</p>	
<p><b>Day 7 Bukhara – Shaxrisabz – Samarkand</b> Leaving for Shaxrisabz (290 km, 4 hours). Excursions along city: ruins of Ak Saray Palace (XIV – XV cent), Dor – ut – Saodat complex (Xazrati Imam mosque) (XIV cent), Jahangir mausoleum (XIV cent); Dor – ut Tilavat complex: Gumbazi Suidan, Kok Gumbaz mosque (XV cent). Transfer to Samarkand (110 km, 2 hours). Accommodation in a hotel.</p>	
<p><b>Day 8 Samarkand</b> Excursion programs on city: Registan square– Ulugbek madrassah (XV cent), Sherdor madrassah (XVII cent), Tilla Kori Madrassah (XVII cent), observatory of Ulugbek (XV cent). Excavation and museum of ancient city Afrasiab, Shaxi – Zinda architectural complex (XI – XV cent), Guri – Emir mausoleum– tomb of Tamerlane (XIV – XV cent), Bibi Khanim mosque.</p>	



<p><b>Day 9 Samarkand - Tashkent</b> After breakfast, leaving for Tashkent (350 km, 5 hours). Transfer to airport. Flight to next destination.</p>
